INCIDENT/ACCIDENT PROCEDURE

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation.
 - Is there a risk of further injury?
 - Listen to what the injured person is saying.
 - Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
 - In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services – 999. (Telephone available in the Bar)
 - The telephone number for NHS Direct is: 0845 46 47 or see www.nhsdirect.nhs.uk
 - Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
 - Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
 - Contact the injured person's parent / carer / guardian/ relative.
 - Complete an Incident / Accident Report Form asap.
