Nets are ONLY available via our booking system to members of Church CC

No other times are available and walk-ups are not allowed.

RULES FOR USE OF THE NETS

- Sessions are 30 minutes long for juniors and 35 minutes long for seniors or 1-1 coaching. Please vacate the net immediately at the end of your session to allow for a 10 minute changeover time.
- Please do not attempt to enter the net until the previous users have left.
- No more than 6 people or two households per net
- Parents of Under 18s must be present and wait for their child in the carpark and they must adhere to social distancing at all times. As at the 29th March 2021 Government & ECB Guidance does not permit spectators on the ground.
- If an under 18 is being coached 1-1, a parent should then be present for Safeguarding reasons.
- Only one net lane can be in operation
- A 10 minute break between sessions is built in to the booking system to allow safe entry/exit.
- Players must come changed and must use their own equipment. All kit bags must be left outside the nets and must not present a hazard. Please ensure you remove all your equipment at the end of your net session
- Batsmen to wear full protective clothing at all times.
- Do not remove batting (or keeping) gloves when batting/practising. Do not throw back balls – use the bat or kick the ball back.
- Kit must not be shared.
- Where possible each player to use one set of balls, they must not be shared between bowlers during a net session. Equipment must be sanitised between sessions.
- Wash hands before and after your session; participants to bring their own hand sanitiser.

- Bring your own drinks (these must not be shared, must not be taken into the net, they must be kept in your bag and must be removed at the end of the net session)
- No spitting; no shining the ball with spit/sweat.
- Avoid unnecessary touching of any surfaces, nets, fixtures, fences
- Toilet facilities and changing rooms are NOT open.
- A basic First Aid kit is available at the nets
- Social distancing - especially 2 metre rule - to be observed at all times.
