## **IMPORTANT UPDATE- CHURCH CC**

Please note that in accordance with Government, ECB & LCF Guidance spectators are not allowed until Stage 3, i.e 17<sup>th</sup> May 2021 at the earliest. However, the Club will be open to members this weekend for hospitality purposes.

Our opening times this weekend will be as follows:

- Saturday 17th 1pm to 6.30pm
- Sunday 18th 1pm to 6.30pm

Our opening is provisional on all Rules, Government Guidance & ECB Guidance being adhered to. All members and visitors must therefore take note of, and fully comply with, the following:

#### **Track and Trace**

- All persons attending Church CC are required to comply with the requirements for venue check-in.
- You may check in via the NHS Covid 19 App using the QR code displayed in the windows of the tearoom & committee room and at all tables or by using the Track & Trace Register which is at the entrance to the Committee Room
- All visitors must now check-in to enter hospitality venues, not just one per group.
- Anyone who does not comply must be refused entry and refused service.

## **Hospitality Service**

Service will be outdoors only and there is no shelter in the event of inclement weather.

A designated specific area for hospitality has been set up along the ground perimeter at the Church end

All seating areas will have table numbers.

# **Hospitality Service – Rules and Restrictions**

The guidelines dictate that food and drinks can **only be ordered and consumed whilst seated.** 

Face masks must be worn at all times and in all areas unless you are seated at a table in the hospitality area.

National social contact rules apply, meaning a maximum of either 6 people, or people from 2 households, can be in a group.

Government guidelines on social distancing must be adhered to at all times whilst on Church CC premises

Do not move furniture around - it has been positioned to support social distancing

Please observe and adhere to all signage when moving around the ground

Keep children seated when in the hospitality areas, and supervise them during toilet visits

The tearoom toilets will be available, and accessible via the main door. Enter only when the green light indicates that it is safe to do so. Face coverings must be worn within the toilets and customers must sanitise on entry and exit from the building; a hand sanitising station has been installed.

Disposable cups, glasses, food trays & cutlery will be used to reduce the potential for spread of covid 19

#### Hospitality – How to Order

To complete an order, you MUST first have completed check-in for Track and Trace. You can check in using the NHS App, QR codes are in the windows of the tearoom & committee room and are also available at the seating areas. If you are unable to use the App you must check in by signing the Track & Trace book at the entrance to the Committee Room

Instructions for ordering will be available at your seating area. The order message needs to include your full name, your table number, any food allergies your party

may have and your order. If you are unable to order via text please speak to a volunteer who is in the hospitality area but do not enter the tearoom.

**Please Note –** There may be delays in serving your orders given the current guidelines we have to follow. Please be patient we will be doing our best!

Payment should be made, if possible, by cash on delivery although card payments can be made.

Face masks must be worn in all areas except when seated in the hospitality area and all social distancing rules must be adhered to.
